



Malcognito Snot Recipe

As any good ogre or malcognito knows, touching even the tiniest bit of malcognito snot will give you malcognitus! So, watch out! But it's always good to have some on hand in case you need a little extra creativity or, you know, to disarm your enemies.





Ingredients

Snot

- 4 ½ tbsp cornstarch
- 3 tbsp water
- Couple dashes of glitter
- One drop **food coloring** (optional)

Bottle

- A small **bottle** (spice jar, pickle jar, jam jar etc.)
- Tape
- Paper
- Pen

Notes

- If you choose to use food coloring, be forewarned, it does stain things. Adjust accordingly, or you will end up looking like Great-Aunt Griselda!
- This can be made outside to avoid the mess.





• **Disposal:** If you choose not to bottle and save your malcognito snot, it's best to scrape it into the trash. Malcognito snot has been known to clog drains, so don't put it down the sink!

Steps

1. Add the cornstarch to a bowl.



2. Add the water.



3. Mix to combine. It will be tough going at first, but will slowly mix up. Adjust proportion of water/cornstarch as you like. Consistency is runny when being poured but thick and solid under pressure.







4. Optional - Add one drop of food coloring. Again, this will stain things, so be careful. I tried blue, yellow, white, and mixed blue and yellow food coloring for a light green. Make whatever color of malcognito snot suites you.



5. Add several dashes of glitter until it as sparkly as you desire. I prefer highly sparkly snot.



6. Enjoy the snotty texture! Playing with malcognito snot is most of the fun. Experiment with rolling it into a ball, pouring it, squishing it. You can stop here, if you don't need others to enjoy the beauty of your snot, and just want to have fun.







7. Use a funnel to pour the malcognito snot into a bottle for safe-keeping (optional). I used an old spice jar from the grocery store, an old vial that held tea, and a metal candle tin. Be creative!



8. Use any scrap of paper and write out the label for your jar. I used a sticky note and wrote "Malcognito Snot" but you can do whatever strikes your fancy.



9. Tape the piece of paper to the outside of the jar.



10. Put on display!!
